

Community Links Portal: Consumer FAQ Sheet

What is the Community Links Portal?

- A secure website that helps community services agencies and health care organizations to collaborate more effectively for their patients.
- The goal of the **Community Links Portal** is to improve your care by sharing specific and limited health related information collected by your Aging Services Access Point (ASAP) with other community health care professionals involved in your care.

Where does the information about me come from?

- After an ASAP Care Manager visits you, they record information about your current health status and service needs in a secure computer database. Certain sections of this information are then displayed on the **Community Links Portal** secure website, only for the health professionals involved in your care to view.

What if I do not wish to share this information with my health care professionals on the website?

- Your information will not be shared through the **Community Links Portal** if you do not want it to be. Simply inform your ASAP Care Manager of your preference at any time.

Can I change my mind?

- Yes. Your ASAP Care Manager can remove access at your request.

What if I have more questions about the Community Links Portal!

- Ask your ASAP Care Manager. They will communicate any issues and concerns you may have with the project team at the Executive Office of Elder Affairs.
