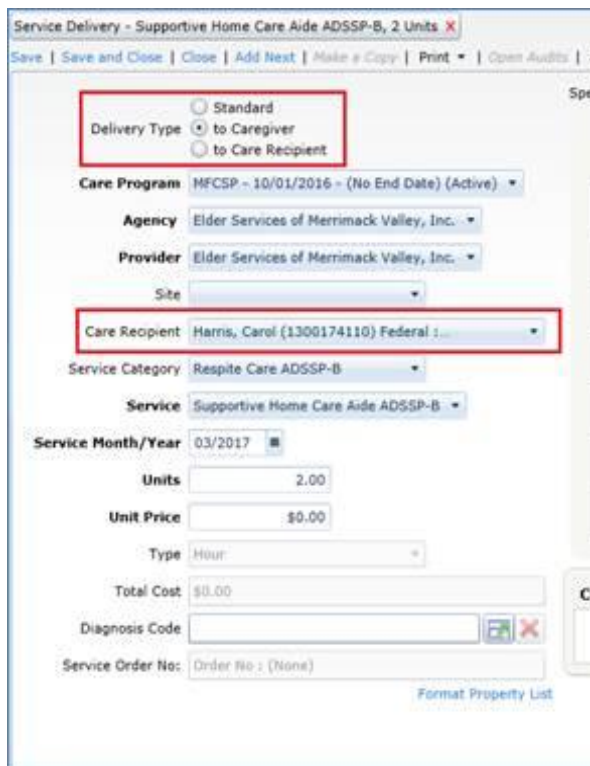


Attachment A - ADSSP Part B Approved Service Deliveries

To document expenditures related to the ADSSP-Part B funding, four new service categories have been added to the Massachusetts Family Caregiver Support Program (MFCSP) care enrollment in SAMS:

- Respite Care ADSSP-B
- Companion Person Centered ADSSP-B
- Technology Counseling/Support/TA ADSSP-B
- Technology ADSSP-B

The new service categories will not be mapped to the State Reporting Tool (SRT) and should be included in any Family Caregiver Support Program reports (such as NAPIS) and/or invoices. All of these new deliveries will be associated with the caregivers' record in SAMS; please see the following screenshot for information on data entry:



I. Respite Care ADSSP-B

The Respite Care ADSSP-B service category contains the following services:

These services can be provided only to caregivers whose care recipient **is not currently enrolled in any Home Care program** and who need temporary respite so they can attend Savvy Caregiver trainings.

For example, a caregiver wants to attend a Savvy Caregiver training and s/he needs 45 minutes to drive both to and from the training location. The respite should cover the two hours of the weekly sessions and the driving time. The service delivery should be entered for four hours weekly for six weeks at the contracted rate per hour.

Agencies need to set up contracts in SAMS for any current providers they want to use for these service deliveries.

II. Companion Person Centered ADSSP-B

The Companion Person Centered ADSSP-B service category contains the following service:

Service Category	Service	Unit	Rate
Companion Person Centered ADSSP-B	Person Centered Companion ADSSP-B	Per Payment	Amount

This service delivery should be used when a voucher or a payment is made directly to a caregiver or provider for respite services on a reimbursement basis and the units of service are not tracked (such as respite scholarships currently used under the MFCSP care enrollment). This service can be provided only to caregivers whose care recipient **is not currently enrolled in any Home Care program** and who need temporary respite so they can attend Savvy Caregiver Trainings.

III. Technology Counseling/Support/TA ADSSP-B

The Technology Counseling/Support/TA ADSSP-B service category includes the following service:

Service Category	Service	Unit	Rate
Technology Counseling/Support/TA ADSSP-B	Technology Counseling/Support/TA ADSSP-B	1 Session per day	No unit rate entered

This service delivery should be used to document counseling/support/technical assistance provided to address caregivers' need for guidance and support in choosing appropriate technologies (including apps). It can also include technical support to use a specific technology provided. This service can be provided to any caregivers, including caregivers of consumers enrolled in any Home Care program.

Caregiver specialists should enter a journal note in SAMS, detailing the conversation with the caregiver about challenges, potential solutions using technology, and types of technologies mentioned.

IV. Technology ADSSP-B

The Technology ADSSP-B service category includes the following services:

Service Category	Service	Unit	Rate
Technology ADSSP-B	Portable Music Player/Music Gift Cards ADSSP-B	Per Payment	\$750 max
Technology ADSSP-B	GPS/Tracking Devices ADSSP-B	Per Payment	\$750 max
Technology ADSSP-B	Electronic Medication System ADSSP-B	Per Payment	\$750 max
Technology ADSSP-B	Video Monitoring ADSSP-B	Per Payment	\$750 max
Technology ADSSP-B	Communication Aids (such as telephone devices and electronic tablets)	Per Payment	\$750 max

These service deliveries should be used to document payments for technologies* delivered to caregivers aimed at solving caregiving challenges, alleviating stress and increasing quality of life. These services **can be provided to caregivers of consumers enrolled in any Home Care program.**

The following types of technologies and counseling are eligible for payments under the ADSSP-Part B Grant:

Technology	Caregivers' Challenges Addressed
Counseling and Support	Caregivers need for guidance and support in choosing appropriate technologies (including apps) to solve specific challenges.
Portable digital music players with personalized playlists	Difficulties managing care recipient's agitation, caregivers' feeling out of control, and the caregivers' need for a positive engagement activity.
GPS and other tracking devices	Caregivers' worry about the care recipient's getting lost and hurting him/herself and caregiver's feeling of powerlessness.
Electronic medication management systems (with no required membership)	Caregivers' inability to effectively manage medication intake.
Communication aids (such as telephone devices and electronic tablets)	Caregivers' isolation and difficulty keeping the recipients' care and the caregivers' daily activities organized.
Video monitoring devices	Inability to effectively manage daily activities.

The maximum award per technology should be \$750 or less per caregiver.
